

SHELLS, SAND, WATER

THE ENDURING STORY OF TABBY

Lumber from trees, bricks from mud, roofs of sod. Through the ages, settlers have used what the earth provides for building materials.

Here in the coastal areas of Georgia and the southeast, nature provided early inhabitants with a unique and remarkably strong building material. Its ingredients, combined in equal measure, are simple: lime (the ash from burned oyster shells), sand, water, and crushed shells. Its name is tabby and it was quite literally the foundation of much that was built along the coast over the centuries.

Tabby was developed in the 13th and 14th centuries on the North African coast and brought to the New World by the Spanish in the 16th century.

The first tabby used by English-speaking people was in Charleston, South Carolina, around 1690. When Georgia became a colony in 1733, settlers from South Carolina brought the "recipe" for this handy building material with them-building forts, chapels, lighthouses, hospitals, sugar mills, barns, breweries, homes and slave quarters.

Native American shell "middens" (prehistoric heaps of discarded shells) were often the source for the quantity of shells needed to make tabby.

The look of this ancient, enduring building material remains quite popular today, but is typically a "false tabby" mix of oyster shells and cement— not the authentic, labor-intensive compound of yesterday.

Examples of historic tabby buildings and ruins can be found in locations throughout Brunswick & The Golden Isles.

MARSH RABBITS

The expansive marshlands that separate the mainland from the barrier islands are home to a variety of animals. One of the most interesting is the marsh rabbit, or sylvilagus palustris.

The marsh rabbit lives in fresh and saltwater marshes in Georgia and throughout the coastal plain from southern Alabama northeastward to southeastern Virginia. Ranging in size from 13 to 17 inches long, it has a brown tail and white or light brown underside. Their color helps them to blend into the shadows, but when their keen eyes and ears detect danger, their large hind feet and strong hindquarters enable them to run up to 30 m.p.h. in a zigzag escape into the dense undergrowth or water.

Rather than digging burrows like their land-bound cousins the hares, marsh rabbits make hollows or depressions in the grass for shelter. In cold weather, they may borrow a burrow made by another animal such as the gopher tortoise.

Ēach year, a female can produce six to seven litters of up to four young each, ensuring their survival from such predators as owls, bobcats, foxes and alligators.

SHIPS FOR VICTORY

During World War II, the J.A. Jones Shipyard in Brunswick bustled with activities critical to America's war efforts. Between 1943 and 1945, the shipyard built 99 vessels. destined for duty in the Atlantic and Pacific loaded with equipment and supplies. The dedication of the men and women of Brunswick's shipyard was best exemplified during December, 1944. Receiving word that six ships would be required during that month, the shipyard workers, instead, guaranteed seven and requested that they not be paid for the extra work required-including work done on Christmas Day! Today, a 23-foot scale replica of a Liberty Ship-City of Brunswick-is displayed on the grounds of the Mary L. Ross Waterfront Park in downtown Brunswick. The replica is the result of a community-wide, four-year fund-raising effort led

Blimps Over Brunswick

Longtime residents of Brunswick & The Golden Isles clearly remember when huge helium airships, or blimps, were a common sight in the skies above the coast. These graceful, lighter-thanair crafts first arrived in 1943, after Brunswick was selected by the U.S. Navy as the site for one of a network of air stations it established to patrol for German U-boats in coastal shipping lanes. Construction of the air station began in September, 1942 and it was opened in January, 1943. The most formidable part of the project was the building of what were at the time the largest wooden structures in the world: two gargantuan hangars, each 1,000 feet long, 300 feet wide and over 200 feet tall-able to hold six football fields-that would house the blimp fleet. Throughout the war, the fleet of airships based here at Naval Air Station Glynco logged thousands of hours of air time in coastal patrols and convoy escorting. In fact, airships from the Brunswick operation can boast that they escorted some 98,000 ships during the war without a single vessel or airship loss. Today, the use of jet aircraft and sophisticated electronics have replaced the blimp in anti-submarine warfare. However, these ungainly looking craft performed a vital mission during World War II. The Navy disestablished the Air Base in 1958 and the blimp hangars were demolished in 1971.

SEA TURTLES

 ${f F}$ or thousands of years, sea turtles have been born on and returned to nest on Georgia's barrier islands. Of the five species of sea turtles found off the Georgia coast, the loggerhead (Caretta caretta) is the only one that consistently nests on the Golden Isles. Hatchlings that emerge from nests on St. Simons Island, Sea Island, Little St. Simons Island and Jekyll Island are the same turtles that will return to nest as adults. From May through August, nesting sea turtles swim ashore under cover of darkness to make their way across the sand, dig their nests and lay their eggs. After the turtle lays her eggs, she returns to the sea. During the 57-day incubation period, the eggs may become victim to ghost crabs, raccoons, dogs, hogs, humans and other predators. Hatchlings generally emerge from the nest in one group. Using visual cues such as light, the sound of the surf and instinct, they make their way to the surf. The odds of their survival are slim; only 60-90 percent of the eggs hatch; just one of every 1,000 hatchlings will live to adulthood. Several organizations throughout the Golden Isles are devoted to protection and preservation of threatened sea turtles and their nests.



LIVE OAK TREES

Visitors are invariably captivated by the beautiful and natural canopy provided by the countless live oaks that grow for so long and so large in this area. So named because their deep green leaves retain their color throughout the year, live oaks are known for their enormous size and vast networks of twisting, winding limbs. In the early days, St. Simons Island was home to a thriving lumber industry. famed throughout the world. In fact, rock-hard oak timbers, cut from Cannon's Point on the Island's north end, were used in 1794 to build the frigate U.S.S. Constitutioncause, in part, for its nickname as "Old Ironsides." In 1874, timbers from the Island were also cut for use in the construction of the Brooklyn Bridge. While many trees in this area are much older, legend holds that the average life span of an oak is 300 years-100 years of growth, 100 years of mature existence, and 100 years of decline.



SAND DUNES

The lovely sand dunes that lie along the ocean shore are a beautiful sight, but not many people know that these dunes actually have their origin on the opposite (marshland) side of the islands. Dead marsh grass from these areas between the barrier islands and the mainland are loosened and carried out toward the sea by the force of receding tides. The grasses then wash up on the beaches where they provide shelter for very hearty species of grasses to grow. These plants hold the sand and make it less susceptible to movement by wind and surf. Eventually, small ridges of sand form and as the process continues, new generations of plants hold more and more layers of sand. As a result, dunes slowly grow larger and larger. The sea oats vou find in mature dunes are vital to dune and seashore stabilization. That's why picking sea oats is prohibited by law-despite their beauty.

KNOBBED WHELKS

The Knobbed Whelk, *Busycon carica*, is recognized as Georgia's official state seashell. The shell houses a snail-like sea creature called a whelk. The outside of the shell has a distinct row of spike-like knobs, known as tubercules, along the outer edge of its shoulder. Though they can grow to a length of 12 inches, most knobbed whelk shells found on our beaches are from 3 to 5 inches long.

When you stroll our beautiful Golden Isles beaches and see something that resembles a spiral shaped string of tiny Japanese paper lanterns, you've found whelk egg cases. Young whelks emerge from their egg cases in tiny, one-whorled shells to feed on the rich bounty of our coastal waters.

Find a whelk shell on our beaches and chances are good that it houses a living creature other than the whelk. Collectors who pick up these shells are often surprised to find hermit crabs. The hermit crab's soft shell makes it vulnerable to predators, so it seeks shelter in sturdier whelk shells. As the hermit crab grows, it moves to larger whelk shells.

To avoid being surprised that you've taken a live creature home, we suggest that whelk shells found on the beach be placed gently back into the surf. Specialty shops in our area offer carefully inspected, uninhabited shells for you to take home and treasure.
